JASPER COUNTY REMC CO-OP FACTS

1. Your co-op was incorporated in 1938.
2. We currently serve approximately 7,540 members.
3. We serve 6.28 members per mile of line.
4. We provided power to over 9,000 meters.
5. There are 7.4 meters per mile of line on our system. About the same as the national co-op average.
6. Jasper County REMC energizes 1,200 miles of line to serve your homes and businesses. Enough to string all the way to Orlando!

NATIONAL ELECTRIC CO-OP FACTS

1. Electric co-ops own and maintain 42% of the nation's distribution power lines.
2. Co-ops are the only type of utility who return capital credits -to the tune of \$1 billion annually- to their members.
3. There are 900 electric co-ops across the U.S.
4. Electric co-ops are present in 47 states.
5. Electric co-ops employ 71,000 people.
6. Electric co-ops have a local and global commitment to rural electrification and improving quality-of-life.
